## INTERNSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Office of Congressman Joaquin Castro offers internships at its Washington, D.C. and San Antonio, Texas offices. The internship program is designed to provide students with an opportunity to learn about the legislative process and/or constituents services.

**Internship Positions Available:** The Washington, DC office is seeking interns to assist the office with a variety of tasks. Interns are responsible for answering phones, researching legislation, attending hearings and briefings, and responding to constituent letters on the various issues that come before the House. As a result, interns have a firsthand look at the legislative process and the many other functions of a congressional office.

Candidates should be interested in public policy, detail-oriented, motivated, organized, willing to learn, and have good phone etiquette. Candidates of all backgrounds are encouraged to apply.

In the San Antonio office, interns may be asked to do a variety of things, including day-to-day office work such as answering phones, writing letters, and assisting with research. In addition, interns may be assigned to assist with constituent casework or work on district-based projects of importance.

**Eligibility:** A candidate must be a graduate student or an undergraduate student.

**General Information:** Internships are paid \$15 dollars an hour. Interns are expected to work between 20 and 40 hours a week during an 8 to 12 week internship period. Internships are offered during the fall, spring or summer semesters. The hours are flexible to accommodate students' hectic course schedules, but generally run from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Interns may receive academic credit if an agreement is made between the Office of Congressman Joaquin Castro and the intern's college or university. All interns are subject to applicable rules of the U.S. House of Representatives, including the Code of Official Conduct, and the policies and procedures of the Office of Congressman Joaquin Castro.

**Application Procedures:** Candidates must complete an application form and submit it with their cover letter, resume, and two-page writing sample. All application items must be submitted as a complete package. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

**Application Deadlines:** Summer program: applications must be postmarked by April 1<sup>st</sup>

Fall program: applications must be postmarked by August 1<sup>st</sup>

Winter/Spring program: applications must be postmarked by November 26<sup>th</sup>
