I am requesting funding for the San Antonio International Airport's EV Charging Resiliency and Expansion Study project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of San Antonio, located at 100 Military Plaza, San Antonio, TX 78205. The proposed project is located at San Antonio International Airport at 9800 Airport Blvd, San Antonio, TX 78216.

The funding would be used for an EV Resiliency Master Plan at the San Antonio International Airport in pursuit of overall electrification. The objective of this project is to position SAT to further invest in increased availability of EV charging and to enable EV charging to utilize emerging battery technology to power EV charging with non-peak electricity. The project will support FAA and San Antonio's efforts to increase fleet electrification which will help reduce emissions and improve air quality.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq.
