## A BILL

For the relief of Alirio Palacios Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ramirez Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ALIRIO
4 PALACIOS GAMEZ, HILDA VERONICA RAMI5 REZ MENDEZ, AND JAYRO IVAN JUAREZ RA6 MIREZ.
7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
8 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
9 Act, Alirio Palacios Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ramirez

Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also known as Jayron Ivan Juarez Mendez and as Jaro Ivan Ramirez 3 Mendez) shall each be eligible for issuance of an immi-4 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec-6 tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful 8 permanent resident. 9 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Alirio Palacios 10 Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ramirez Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also known as Jayron Ivan Juarez 12 Mendez and as Jaro Ivan Ramirez Mendez) enters the United States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), each such named individual shall be considered 14 15 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under 16 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of 18 the date of the enactment of this Act. 19 (c) Waiver of Grounds for Removal or Denial 20 OF ADMISSION.— 21 IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 22 212(a) and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nation-23 ality Act, Alirio Palacios Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ra-24 mirez Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also

known as Jayron Ivan Juarez Mendez and as Jaro

1	Ivan Ramirez Mendez) may not be removed from the
2	United States, denied admission to the United
3	States, or considered ineligible for lawful permanent
4	residence in the United States by reason of any
5	ground for removal or denial of admission that is re-
6	flected in the records of the Department of Home-
7	land Security or the Visa Office of the Department
8	of State on the date of the enactment of this Act.
9	(2) Recession of outstanding order of
10	REMOVAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security
11	shall rescind any outstanding order of removal or de-
12	portation, or any finding of inadmissibility or de-
13	portability, that has been entered against Alirio
14	Palacios Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ramirez Mendez, or
15	Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also known as Jayron
16	Ivan Juarez Mendez and as Jaro Ivan Ramirez
17	Mendez) by reason of any ground described in para-
18	graph (1).
19	(d) Deadline for Application and Payment of
20	FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
21	plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
22	tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
23	within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
24	(e) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
25	Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-

idence to each of Alirio Palacios Gamez, Hilda Veronica Ramirez Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also known as Jayron Ivan Juarez Mendez and as Jaro Ivan 4 Ramirez Mendez), the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1, during the current or next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the country of the 8 alien's birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total number of immi-10 grant visas that are made available to natives of the country of the alien's birth under section 202(e) of such Act. (f) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION TREAT-12 MENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural parents, brothers, and sisters of Alirio Palacios Gamez, Hilda 14 15 Veronica Ramirez Mendez, and Jayro Ivan Juarez Ramirez (also known as Jayron Ivan Juarez Mendez and as 16 Jaro Ivan Ramirez Mendez) shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or status 18

under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
