1 SEC. 2. EXTENSION TO THE CARIBBEAN COMMUNITY.

2 The provisions of the International Organizations Immunities Act (22 U.S.C. 288 et seq.) may be extended to 3 4 the Caribbean Community in the same manner, to the same extent, and subject to the same conditions as such 5 6 provisions may be extended to a public international organization in which the United States participates pursuant 7 8 to any treaty or under the authority of any Act of Congress authorizing such participation or making an appro-9 10 priation for such participation.
