2 (a) Defined Term.—In this section, the term "ASEAN" means the Association of Southeast Asian Na-4 tions. 5 (b) Establishment.—The Secretary of State is authorized to enter into a public-private partnership for the 6 purposes of establishing a US-ASEAN Center in the United States to support United States economic and cultural engagement with Southeast Asia. 10 (c) Functions.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Secretary of State and the US-ASEAN Cen-11 ter established pursuant to subsection (b) may— 13 (1) provide grants for research to support and 14 elevate the importance of the US-ASEAN partner-15 ship; 16 facilitate activities to strengthen US-ASEAN trade and investment; 17 18 (3) expand economic and technological relation-19 ships between ASEAN countries and the United 20 States into new areas of cooperation; 21 (4) provide training to United States citizens 22 and citizens of ASEAN countries that improve peo-23 ple-to-people ties; 24 (5) develop educational programs to increase
